Parent/Chaperone Agreement

- Family camp is about spending quality family time together. Camp His Way does not supply childcare for this program. Parents are the assigned chaperones for the children of the family.
- Parents are expected to supervise their children at all times during their stay.
- Parents are responsible and liable for the actions of their attending group.
- Parents are expected to maintain order in the cabins and the area in which they are staying.
- Parents are expected to be familiar with and enforce the rules and regulations of Camp His Way, as set forth in the Camp Policies below.
- Parents should report any damages immediately to Camp His Way Staff.

Camp His Way Family Camp Waiver Part I

I, my child and/or my family (herein known as the "Guest") will be attending an event at Camp His Way. I hereby authorize Camp His Way to make arrangements for or give any medical attention to the Guest, emergency or otherwise, that is deemed necessary under the circumstances by the sole discretion of Camp His Way. I hereby give permission to the physician selected by Camp His Way and or the Sponsoring Organization to hospitalize and/or secure proper treatment as the physician may deem appropriate. I further understand that medical treatment may be several minutes away in the event of a medical emergency.

The proposed activities provided by Camp His Way and/or the Sponsoring Organization (herein known as the "Recreational Activities") require participation in physical exercises which are, by their nature, physically demanding. Many of the activities will challenge the Guest and cause surges of blood pressure and pulse rates. It is imperative that the Guest is free of any diseases or injuries, heart related or otherwise, which might create undue risks to themselves and/or to any other participants. The Recreational Activities provided by Camp His Way and/or the Sponsoring Organization may include, but are not limited to, the following list; indoor and outdoor games, marksmanship, boating, fishing, swimming, watersliding, zip line, challenge course activities, and various rides. All Guests participating in the Recreational Activities may be exposed to the elements of nature, including temperature extremes and inclement weather.

- I hereby apply for registration for all listed Guests for the camping services indicated in the application.
- I agree to the price and terms as stated in the application for admission.
- I have read the camp policies and application and agree to abide by the conditions outlined.
- I will be held responsible for any damages caused by our Guests to the camp, facilities or any other property.
- I consent to the use by CHW and its agents in our Guests' image in camp photographs, videos, social network and new media and forfeit any monetary claim for any usage.

I hereby acknowledge that during the Guests' voluntary participation in the Recreational Activities, that certain risks and dangers may occur due to accidents, which may include, but are not limited to, the hazards of depending on other people, being at various heights, activities in remote places without medical facilities, the forces of nature, loss or damage to personal property, illness, physical or mental injury, not excluding fatality. I hereby assume all mentioned risks and those which are not specifically foreseeable, and will hold Camp His Way, including its staff and Board of Directors, and the Sponsoring Organization harmless from any and all liability, claims and demands of every kind whatsoever, whether for bodily injury, property damage or otherwise, which may arise from or in connection with the Guest's participation in any activities arranged by Camp His Way or the Sponsoring Organization. This release to hold harmless Camp His Way shall survive the end of the stay at Camp His Way and will apply even if an injury is caused in whole or in part by the ordinary negligence, gross negligence or willful misconduct of Camp His Way Management, Staff, or Volunteers.

All Families/Groups/Guests shall be required to indemnify, defend, and hold Camp His Way Inc. harmless from any injury (and any resulting or related claim, action, loss, liability, or reasonable expense, including attorney's fees and other fees and court and other costs) occurring on any portion of the Camp property. This indemnity shall survive the end of the stay at Camp His Way and will apply even if an injury is caused in whole or in part by the ordinary negligence, gross negligence or willful misconduct of Camp His Way Management or Staff or volunteers.

Read this Agreement carefully. It includes important information about Camp His Way's activities and describes certain protection sought by Camp His Way if you, your child, or another family member/ Guest becomes ill or suffers some other loss due to infection of the CoronaVirus (COVID-19) that may have been caused from being at Camp His Way or from being exposed by someone else who was at Camp His Way.

In consideration of the services of Camp His Way, I, Parent, acknowledge and agree as follows:

Activities:

The activities of Camp His Way include a variety of traditional sports, games, activities, and events that will make it impossible to consistently implement any social distancing of 6 feet or less that may be recommended by any known government authorities. Camp is a place where campers, counselors, and staff are often in contact and near each other every day and every night. This includes but not limited to: eating at the table together at meals in the dining hall, playing sports like basketball, tetherball, carpetball, and GaGa ball where the sports ball is touched by many participants, and sleeping inside the dorms where cots and bunk beds are often less than six feet apart.

Risks:

Camp His Way will be taking more health precautions this summer. Guests that arrive to camp with a fever, have a cough, have been exposed in the past two weeks to a friend or family member who had the Coronavirus, or in the past two weeks have traveled outside of the State of Texas, WILL NOT be allowed into camp. Other precautions during camp include: encouraging and enforcing more handwashing, more use of hand sanitizers, more wiping down of doorknobs and high use areas with antibacterial wipes, etc. Camp His Way plans to send any guest or staff home that have a high temperature. But even taking these and other extra precautions, guest will still be exposed to the risk of contracting the Coronavirus or possibly some other illness.

The activities and risks of Camp His Way are an integral part of the summer camp experience. If eliminated, campers would be deprived of the opportunity for the growth and development which Camp His Way and its campers and families expect.

Acknowledgement and Assumption of Risks:

I, Parent, have read and understand the Camp His Way activities and risk of exposure to the Coronavirus. I acknowledge and assume the risks and dangers described above with my child being enrolled at Camp His Way. I have discussed the activities and risks with my child, who understands them and wishes to participate in the activities of the summer camp community.

AGREEMENTS OF RELEASE AND INDEMNITY: I, PARENT, FOR MYSELF AND, TO THE EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW, ON BEHALF OF MY CHILD, AGREE TO RELEASE AND DISCHARGE (AGREEING TO MAKE NO CLAIM, AND NOT TO SUE) CAMP HIS WAY, AND THEIR RESPECTIVE OWNERS, MEMBERS, DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, BOARD OF DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES, CONTRACTORS AND VOLUNTEERS (INDIVIDUALLY AND COLLECTIVELY REFERRED TO AS "RELEASED PARTIES") WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL CLAIMS RELATED TO CONTRACTING THE CORONAVIRUS AND ANY LOSS, BODILY INJURY, OR DAMAGES ASSOCIATED FROM IT WHICH I OR MY CHILD MAY SUFFER, ARISING OUT OF OR IN ANY WAY RELATED TO HER BEING ENROLLED IN THE CAMP, AND ON OR OFF THE CAMP PREMISES. (continued from previous page) **(THAT IS DEFEND AND PAY, INCLUDING COSTS AND ATTORNEYS FEES) THE RELEASED PARTIES FROM CLAIMS BROUGHT BY OTHER MEMBERS OF MY, OR MY CHILD'S FAMILY, AND CLAIMS BROUGHT BY OTHERS, INCLUDING OTHER CAMPERS, WHO CLAIM A LOSS CAUSED BY MY CHILD.**

THESE AGREEMENTS OF RELEASE AND INDEMNITY INCLUDE CLAIMS CAUSED OR CLAIMED TO BE CAUSED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY THE NEGLIGENCE, BUT NOT THE GROSS NEGLIGENCE, OF A RELEASED PARTY. I UNDERSTAND THAT IN SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT I, FOR MYSELF AND FOR MY CHILD, TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW, SURRENDER THE RIGHT TO MAKE A CLAIM OR FILE A LAWSUIT AGAINST A RELEASED PARTY, FOR PERSONAL INJURY AND EVEN DEATH.

Any dispute between Camp His Way or another Released Party and me or my child shall be governed by the substantive laws (not including the laws which might apply the laws of another jurisdiction) of the State of Texas, and any mediation or suit shall occur or be filed and maintained exclusively in Angelina County, Texas, to the jurisdiction of which court or courts I hereby consent, for myself and my child.

If any part of this agreement is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the remainder of the agreement nevertheless will be in full force and effect.

This Agreement and Waiver of Liability does not supersede, circumvent, or cancel Camp His Way's Guest Waiver, but instead works together in conjunction with it.

I, Parent or legal guardian, have read and accept the terms and conditions of this Agreement, and acknowledge and agree that it shall, to the fullest extent allowed by law, be effective upon me, every guest including in my group registration, my child, and our respective heirs, personal representatives, estates and family members.

Family Camp - What to Bring

Packing List:

- Bedding (twin sized bunk bed). Sheets and blankets work or sleeping bag and sheet.
- Pillow and towel
- Closed toe shoes for activities
- Watershoes (not flip flops)
- Swim suit and coverup
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, etc)
- Dirty clothes bag
- Shirts and shorts
- Underclothes and socks
- Kid safe sunscreen and insect spray
- Bible

Optional:

- Hammock or camp chairs - relaxing with the family is encouraged!
- PFDs (personal flotation device) required for boating of any kind - camp has loaners
- Fishing pole and tackle (Texas fishing license required for anyone over the age of 16)
- Safety Glasses for any marksmanship riflery (camp has loaners)
- Personal water bottles (camp will have large water coolers and disposable cups at activities)
- Bicycle and helmets - feel free to explore the forest roads as a family

Do NOT Bring:

- RVs - we do not have any hookups or parking areas
- Pets - we have plenty of furry friendly friends already
- ATVs - illegal on the roads, lake front, and forest. Not allowed on camp property unless it's an adult driven golf cart for handicap use.
- No personal use of firearms allowed on the Marksmanship Range
- Want to bring your own boat? There is a community boat ramp half a mile from camp (\$5 launch fee.)

Family Camp Policies

Check-in: Check in is from 1-2pm Monday or Friday. Please arrive in that one hour window. All guests must complete health screening, turn in completed waivers, and receive dorm assignments before settling in. Any pending camp fee balance is due on arrival.

Departure: 1pm Wednesdays or Sundays

Health Check: Guests will be screened for fever upon arrival. Please pre-screen your group before departing for camp to avoid being turned away at registration.

Parking: All vehicles must be parked in the designated parking area. Please do not drive vehicles through camp.

Bedding: Guests must furnish their own bedding, pillows, and towels. Bunks are twin size.

Legal Waiver:

All Guests must agree, sign, and turn in all waivers in this packet on arrival.

Activities:

- Parents must supervise their children at all times.
- Life jackets must be worn at all times for any boating activity.
- Families may swim at their own risk OFF SITE (400 yards down the road at Lake Sam Rayburn)
- Anyone failing to comply with rules of the Camp and applicable State laws shall be denied activity access.
- Inclement or approaching inclement weather conditions will result in the cancellation of activities until weather conditions are deemed safe by the Camp Director.
- Certain activities such as zipline, single kayaking, marksmanship, suspended waterslide and Banana Boat are limited to posted ages and weights.

Security: Camp gates are locked after registration to keep a secure campground and monitor in and out traffic. If a guest needs to leave early please notify camp staff. Unregistered outside guests are not allowed while camp is in session.

Food: We try to serve great food at Camp His Way. But we will also have vending machines available for Family Camp 2020 on the dorm porch. Families are welcome to bring their own snacks and coolers, but please keep anything from leaking on the dorm floors. Gluten free menu is available for an extra charge during registration. We do not have facilities available to allow families to prepare their own meals. For more complicated food allergies please contact the camp beforehand so we can make plans.

Dress:

SHOES MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES.

For safety reasons water shoes must be worn in the lake while swimming. Flip-flops are not adequate and will not stay on in the soft lake bottom.

All guests must dress in keeping with modesty and Christian ideals. Please encourage campers to wear a coverup and have modest swim attire.

Restrictions:

- No alcoholic beverages, tobacco in any form, narcotics or illegal drugs of any kind are permitted on the Campgrounds.
- All medications and cleaning supplies **must be kept out of reach of children.**
- All profanity, immoral conduct of any nature, and immodest dress are forbidden at Camp His Way.

First Aid: First aid and emergency care will be available. The First Aid station is located by the Camp Office. Emergency procedures are posted. The Camp Director should be notified of any emergency. We are in a rural location and hospitals are a significant distance away.

Phones & Internet: Landline phones are only available for emergency use. It is a business and we ask that calls be limited. We have slow rural wi-fi available if needed but encourage families to stay as “screen free” as possible and enjoy each other’s company during their stay.

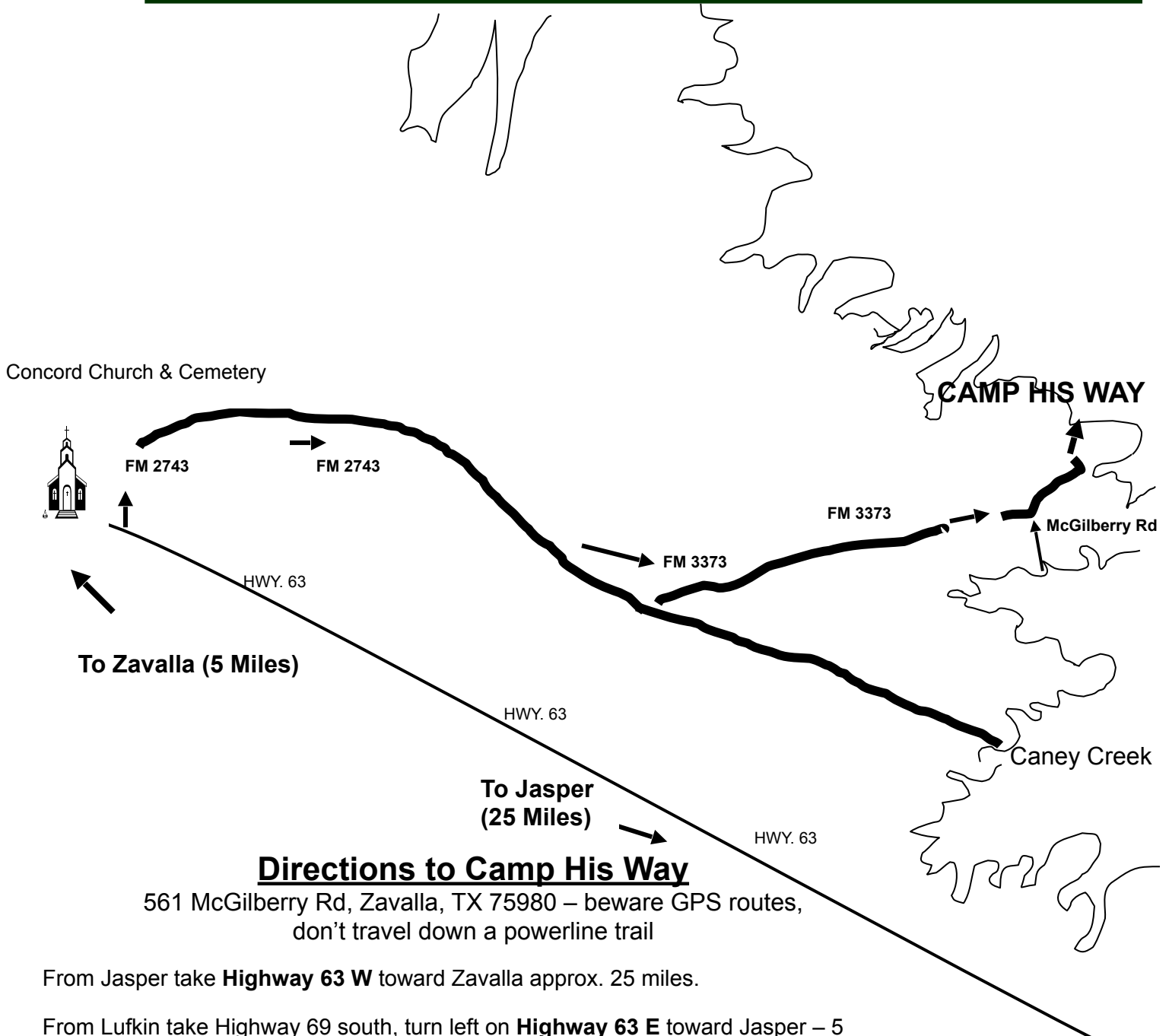

561 McGilberry Rd, Zavalla, TX 75980 – beware GPS routes,
don't travel down a powerline trail

From Jasper take **Highway 63 W** toward Zavalla approx. 25 miles.

From Lufkin take Highway 69 south, turn left on **Highway 63 E** toward Jasper – 5 miles.

From Beaumont take Highway 69 N, turn right on **Highway 63 E** toward Jasper – 5 miles.

1. Turn on **FM 2743** (Concord Baptist Church & Cemetery)
2. Stay on **FM 2743** for about 4 miles
3. Turn left on **FM 3373** (sign-Black Forest Community)
4. Go 1½ Miles
5. At "Y" stay to the right, follow curve for 0.3 miles
6. Turn left – **McGilberry Road** (Angelina Road 334) go ½ mile
7. Camp on left – wooden fence – Camp His Way Sign
